

FLORIDA SCHOOLS IMPACT REPORT

2023-2024

After starting at a 3rd grade reading level in 2023-24, and engaging in 1+ semesters of remediation:

93% Increased by at least one grade level

78% Increased by at least two grade levels

55% Increased by three plus grade levels

The average participant is reading **three grade levels higher**.

2,275

off-track students graduated with a **high school diploma**.

75% achieved a GPA of **2.0 or higher** after 1+ semester.

1.52 Average GPA upon entering our schools.

1,278

off-track students graduated **on time** with their graduation cohort.

Typical Student Referred to Us:

96% were below grade level in reading (avg. 3rd grade)

98% were below grade level in math (avg. 4th grade)

Approaching **18 years old** and **two or more years behind** their expected grade level.

Average number of credits earned at just **9.2**. This is **14.8 credits behind** the total needed to graduate at a traditional high school.



40% were parenting or responsible for the care of a family member.

39% were working full or part-time jobs to help support themselves or family.
